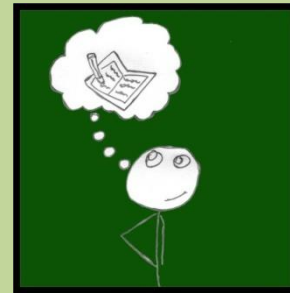

- Check here if you would like to include two books, which will be given away as door prizes. This is optional and helps the symposium promote literacy. The books must not be erotic, illicit, profane or satanic. They must be new or gently used and may be for adults or children. If you are an author and have chosen to provide two books, they should be books you authored. If you are not an author, you may choose any two books that meet the criteria mentioned above.

**Vendor Provisions and Restrictions:**

A table of at least 8 ft. with two chairs will be provided. You will need to bring a table covering that hangs to the floor. You may not place anything on the walls, and your products and décor may not extend more than two feet horizontally and three feet vertically past your table. Electrical outlets will not be provided, but you may use batteries for any electronic needs. Any products or display items that produce sound must be turned off during presentations and may only be used during breaks and lunch periods. Products may not be left unattended, and you are solely responsible for all of your items as well as any currency.
